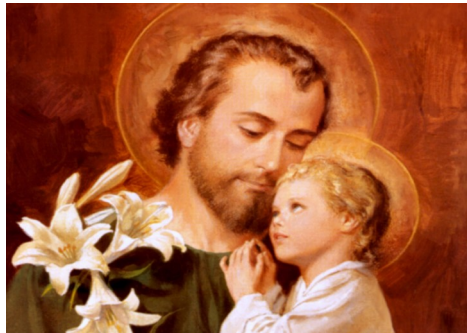
Registration will not be accepted by email or voicemail.
