Rite of Sending Catechumens for the Rite of Election

On Sunday 19 February 2023, you are welcome to the Rite of Sending Catechumens for the Rite of Election at Resurrection Church at the 11am Mass. During this celebration the two Catechumens who are preparing for full initiation into the Catholic faith through Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation, will sign the Book of the Elect to be presented to the Archbishop at the Rite of Election on the first Sunday of Lent.

What is the Rite of Election?

The second step in Christian initiation is the liturgical rite called the Rite of Election. This step takes place each year on the First Sunday of Lent. During this rite, the catechumens formally declare their desire to join the Church and present the Book of the Elect to the Archbishop, giving them the title "members of the elect."

For those preparing to enter the Church at the Easter Vigil, the Rite of Election will be held on Saturday 25 February at St Joseph Basilica. After several months of formation and preparation, the catechumens gather with the Archbishop, other catechumens, pastors, and RCIA teams of many other parishes. On the basis of the testimony of sponsors and catechists, the Archbishop, representing the entire Church, admits the catechumens: "I now declare you to be members of the Elect, to be initiated into the sacred mysteries at the next Easter Vigil."
