


Sign up for FORMED it's easy to join. Just follow these steps:

## 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading – Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15: The Israelites complained of hunger, so God promised to send bread from heaven and meat at dusk to demonstrate His power and care.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 78: God provided manna from heaven as food and led the faithful to His holy land, demonstrating His power and care.

Second Reading – Ephesians 4:17, 20-24: Discard your old ways and renew your mind. Embrace a new self, crafted in righteousness and holiness, as taught by Jesus Christ.

Gospel – John 6:24-35: Jesus teaches in Capernaum, telling the crowd to seek eternal sustenance. He identifies himself as the bread of life, promising that those who come to him will never hunger or thirst.



## An Invitation that Keeps Inviting ...

Are you curious about the Catholic faith? Would you like to learn more about the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church? Do you wonder, how someone joins the Catholic

If "yes" to any of these questions, come and join the journey that begins with your questions. You are invited to participate in a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), a process through which one may join the Catholic Church, if one desires or feels called to do so.

RCIA is the process through which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church, whether never baptized, baptized in a different Christian community or not fully initiated in the Catholic Church. Participants begin of journey of enquiring and learning about Scripture, nurturing a relationship with God, becoming familiar with Catholic teachings and practices, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

The Church extends an invitation to all who wish to learn more about the Catholic faith and to become members of the Catholic Church.

Who can come

Someone of no faith or from another faith tradition who wishes to convert to the Catholic faith

Someone who was baptized in another Christian community and wishes to become a member of the Catholic faith community

Someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church, but never received the other sacraments of initiation — Eucharist and Confirmation.

The RCIA process will begin on Thursday 17 October 2024. Sessions will take place bi-weekly on Thursdays at 630-8pm at Resurrection Meeting Room, 10555-50A Street.
