

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time—October 26, 2024

First Reading – <u>Jeremiah 31:7-9</u>: The LORD promises to bring back the remnant of Israel from the north, comforting and guiding them as a father, ensuring a safe return for all, including the vulnerable.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 126: The LORD restored Zion's captives, filling us with joy. Nations recognized God's deeds. We pray for renewed fortunes, knowing those who sow in tears will reap in joy, bringing in their harvest.

Second Reading – <u>Hebrews 5:1-6</u>: High priests are chosen from among men to offer sacrifices for sins. Christ, called by God, is a priest forever in the order of Melchizedek, not by self-glorification.

Gospel – Mark 10:46-52: Bartimaeus, a blind beggar, called out to Jesus for mercy. Despite being told to be quiet, he persisted. Jesus healed him, saying his faith had saved him. Bartimaeus then followed Jesus.
