

This year the No Room In the Inn Campaign is supporting Youth Empowerment & Support Services (YESS) to replace the roof on the Whyte Avenue facility: YESS's Whyte Avenue Facility, built in 1911 houses their Youth Support Centre (YSC). The YSC is an evolution in youth care and crisis management. The facility's roof is in dire need of replacement. The building has been zoned as a shelter and transitional housing building since YESS's inception in 1981.


Sign up for FORMED it's easy to join. Just follow these steps:






NATIONAL VISITATION OF THE RELICS OF
