Ascension of the Lord
Sunday June 1, 2025
Gospel: Luke 24.46-53

Having conquered death, the Ascension of the Lord commemorates the return of Jesus to his heavenly home, 40 days after his Resurrection. This event, as described in the Acts of the Apostles, marks Jesus' final departure from earthly life, ascending into heaven in the sight of his disciples. The Ascension signifies the culmination of Jesus' earthly mission and his exaltation as Lord, seated at the right hand of God, and the beginning of his reign in heaven.

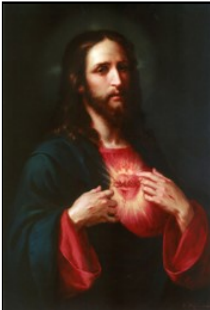
