An Invitation that Keeps Inviting ...

Participants begin of journey of enquiring and learning about Scripture, nurturing a relationship with God, becoming familiar with Catholic teachings and practices, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

The Church extends an invitation to all who wish to learn more about the Catholic faith and to become members of the Catholic Church.

Who can come

- Someone of no faith or from another faith tradition who wishes to convert to the Catholic faith
- Someone who was baptized in another Christian community and wishes to become a member of the Catholic faith community
- Someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church, but never received the other sacraments of initiation Eucharist and Confirmation.

The RCIA process will begin on Thursday 16 October 2025. Sessions will take place bi-weekly on Thursdays at 630-8pm at Resurrection Meeting Room, 10555-50A Street.
